Thank you to everyone who attended the 2023 KFRW Legislative Day in Frankfort on Feb. 28. Kay Hensley, our 3rd Vice President, did a wonderful job organizing the day. We heard from members of the House and Senate as well as our constitutional officers. Members enjoyed connecting with one another and building relationships

with members from other clubs. Pictures are included in this newsletter. There is much activity at this time in the General Assembly. If you have an opinion to share on a particular bill, the most effective way is to call the Legislative Message Line at 800-372-7181 and leave a message. In order to see what bills have been filed, check the status of bills, and to read the exact wording of a bill, go to <https://legislature.ky.gov/Legislation/Pages/default.aspx>. You are also able to link to a KET site where you can watch the Legislature in session.

Remember to turn in all your Political and Campaign hours to the person in your club designated to report those to NFRW. (If your club is not reporting them, you might want to volunteer!) Kentucky has 13 clubs that have reported: Breathitt, Fayette, Fleming, Jessamine, Kenton, Madison, McCracken, Nelson, Oldham, South Central KY, Scott, Trigg, and WROCK. In the last reporting period, KY totaled 43,345 hours which equates to \$1,300,350 worth of political and campaign contributions. While this is a great number, I am certain that we have many hours unreported! Anything that you do of a political nature or campaign work should be reported.

Want your club to be recognized nationally at the 2023 NFRW Convention? Are you proud of your club and the work you do? Then make sure that your club applies for the Achievement Award. We have such great clubs in Kentucky and all deserve to be recognized. Ask your club president about it and offer help.
